

# ONLINE SOCIOLOGY BACHELOR'S DEGREE ADMISSIONS PROCESS

- Apply to UNC using the online application at <http://www.unco.edu/admissions/apply.asp>
  - a. While completing the application, make sure you indicate in the "Extended Studies programs only" section that you are planning to enroll in the "Sociology: Applied Sociology BA (Online-only degree completion)."
  - b. Notify Sociology ([sociology@unco.edu](mailto:sociology@unco.edu)) that you have applied. Your UNC acceptance will also officially admit you into the Online Sociology Bachelor's Degree Completion program.
  - c. Make sure to have sealed official transcripts sent to UNC for all previously earned credit. UNC admissions will use your submitted transcripts to determine credit towards overall degree completion.
- Complete the Sociology Online Bachelor's Degree Completion Evaluation Form ([http://unconline.edu/future/undergrad/UGDocs/Soc\\_BA\\_Online\\_Transfer\\_Eval.pdf](http://unconline.edu/future/undergrad/UGDocs/Soc_BA_Online_Transfer_Eval.pdf)) regarding credit towards the Sociology major requirements and email to [sociology@unco.edu](mailto:sociology@unco.edu) or mail to: Sociology Department, Campus Box 142, Greeley, CO 80639.
- Transcripts are screened by an advisor.
  - a. You will receive a welcome email from the Sociology Department informing you of:
    1. The status of courses completed toward the sociology curriculum
    2. Any Liberal Arts Core classes you still need to complete
    3. Your advisor's name
    4. Your next steps

- If you are missing any coursework below, complete the requirements. Many of these are available online from UNC. Visit [http://www.unconline.edu/future/indiv\\_courses.shtml](http://www.unconline.edu/future/indiv_courses.shtml).
  - a. Approximately **60** semester credit hours completed by time of Sociology program start, with the Liberal Arts Core completed.
  - b. The following courses or transfer equivalents should have been completed, or are in progress, prior to program admittance:
    1. Principles of Sociology
    2. Introduction to Statistics

## Please Note the Graduation and Program Requirements

- a. All 17 courses for the Sociology: Applied Sociology emphasis must be completed.
  1. SOC 100 and STAT 150 (prerequisites)
  2. The eight core Sociology courses (20+ credit hours)
  3. Three courses (nine credits) in your chosen concentration area and 12 credits of elective Sociology courses
- b. Graduation requirements required by the University.
  1. Completion of the Liberal Arts Core requirements
  2. 120 total credits
  3. 30 credits taken at UNC: 20 of those taken last so that they are the most recent
